Applicants demonstrating strong leadership potential and a commitment to career development in the public sector.

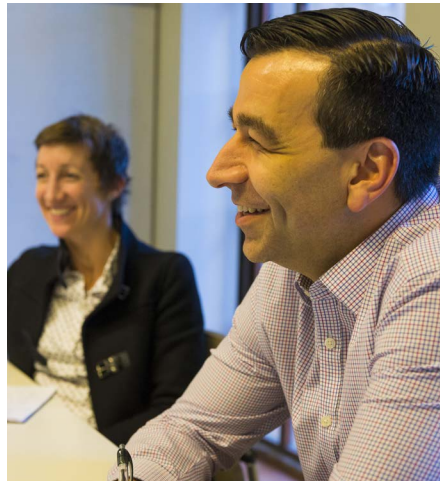
