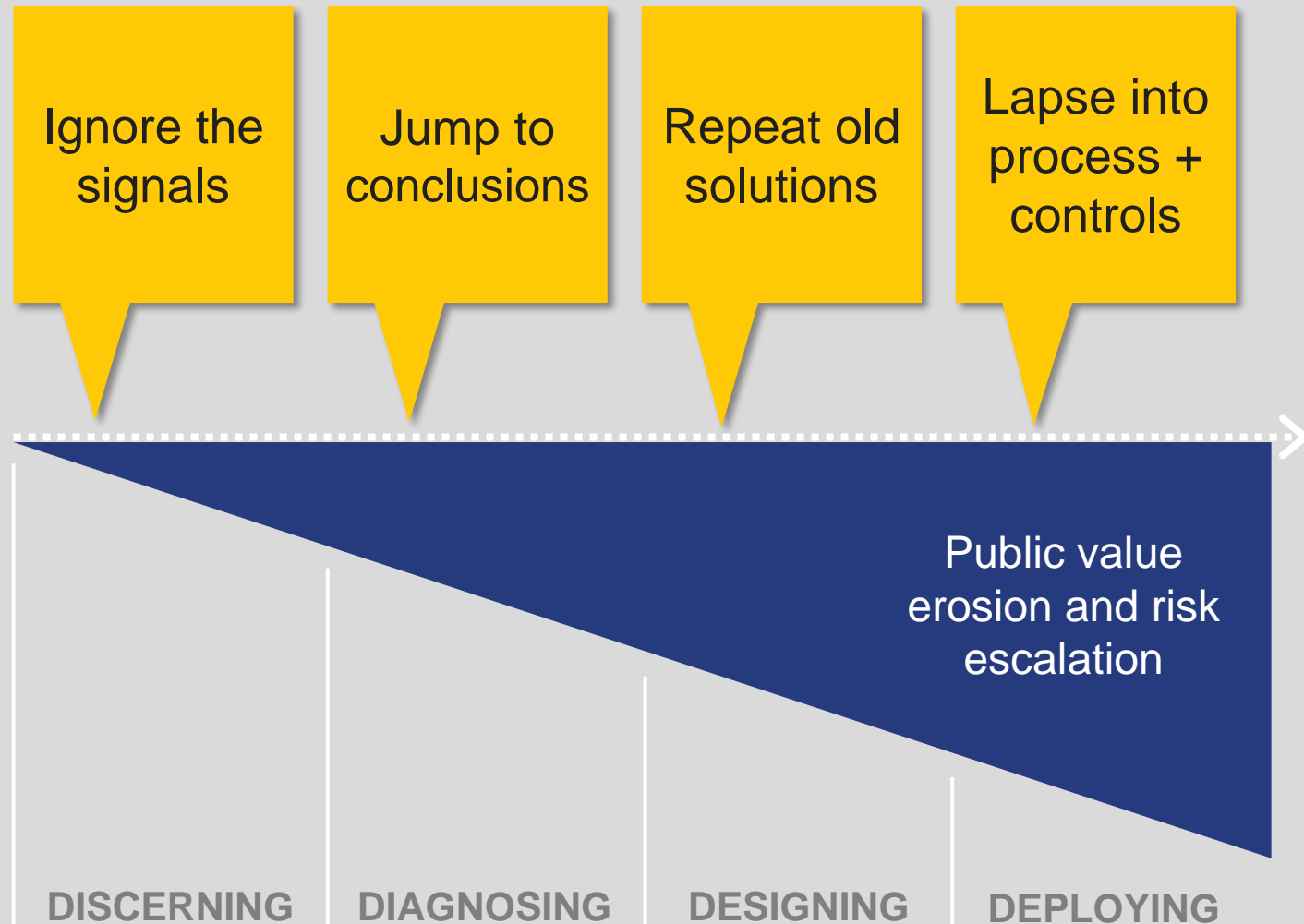

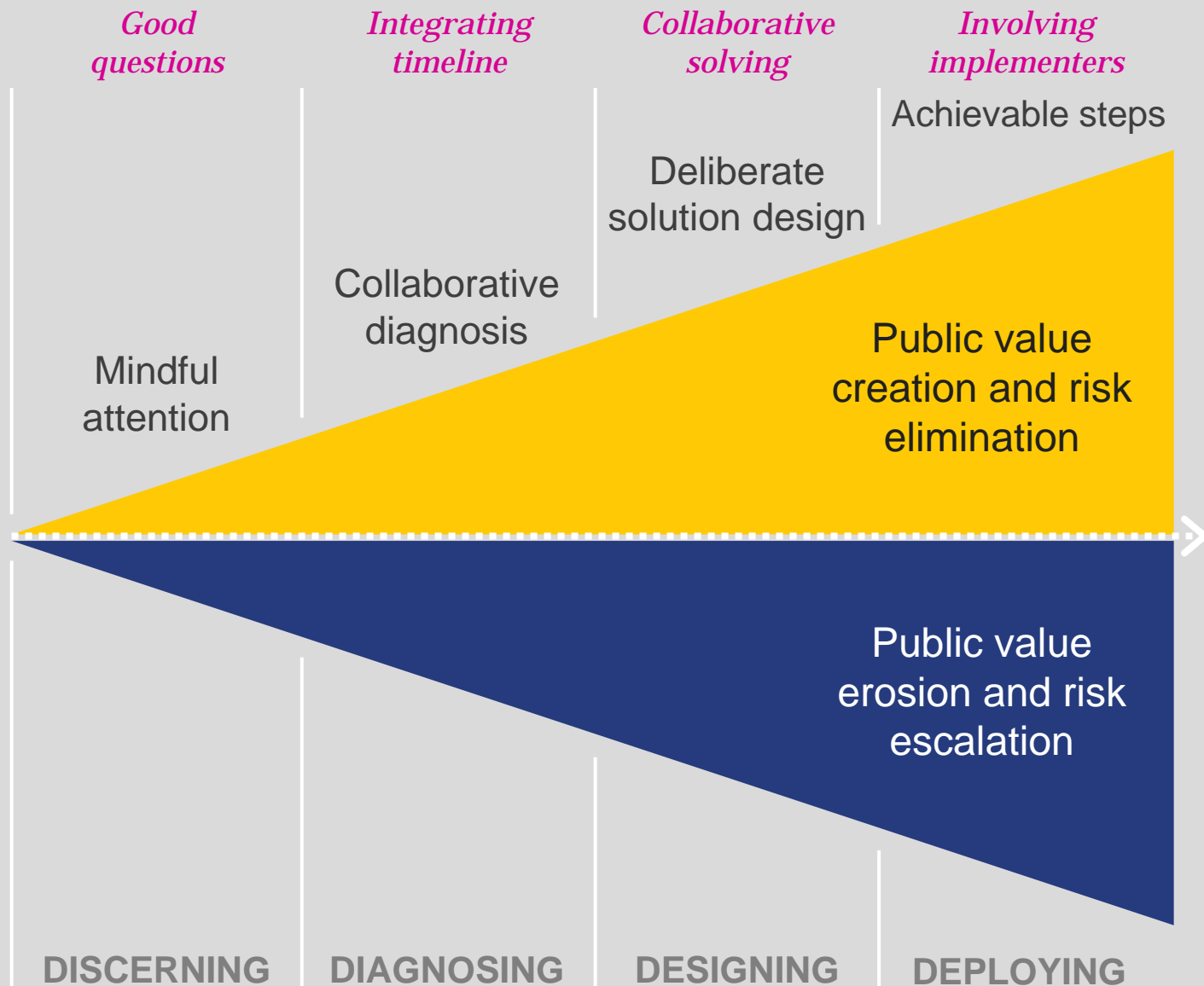

of a similar mistake



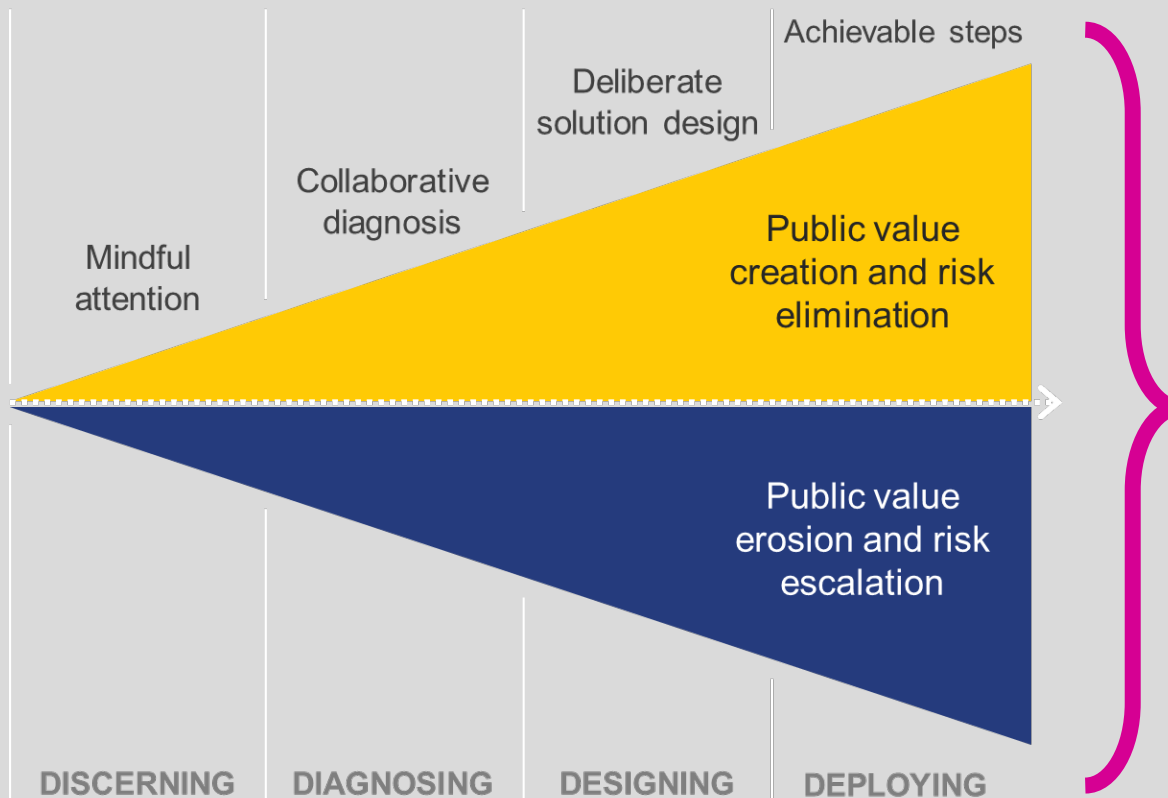

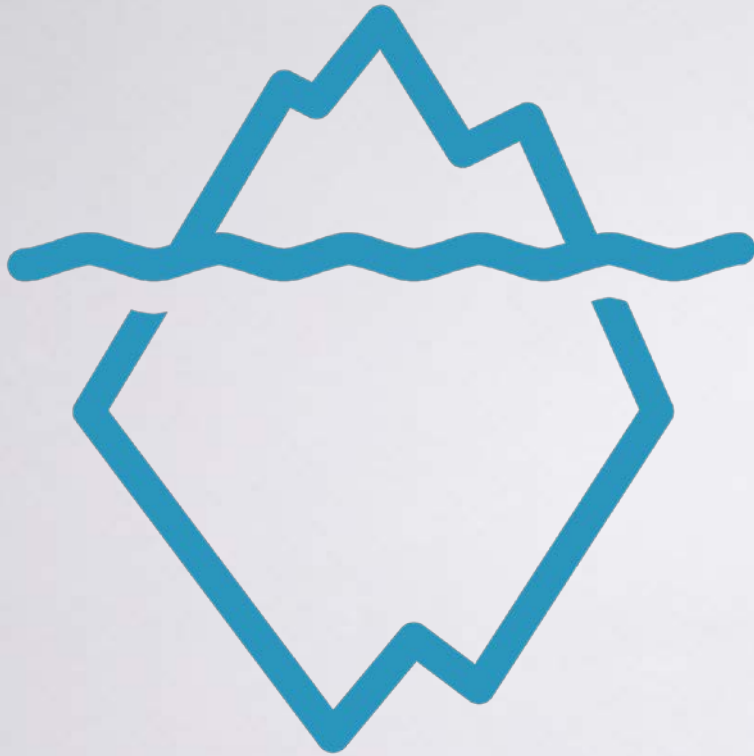
